- Exchanging best practices and co-developing Al Academy programs with the international community through projects (e.g. Erasmus+, COSME,...) and ULB CIVIS and VUB EUTOPIA Networks;
- Organising the promotion of the Al Academy programs in close collaboration with the Marketing & Communications team;
- Managing the FARI trainer pool and organize train-the-trainer sessions when onboarding new trainers for recurring trainings;
- Coordinating planning, deployment and monitoring of the "open" Al Academy programs in close collaboration with our trainers and central staff team;
- Aligning requests for "on demand" trainings with the existing portfolio,
- Coordinate our training offers and coordinate planning, deployment and monitoring of the sessions in close collaboration with our trainers and central staff support team;
- From time to time, take care of introductory trainings or demo tours yourself, to develop a good sense of the audiences we serve and their needs and challenges.
